2. Rules Interpreter, Loretta Dressler reviewed Boys Modified Volleyball Rules:  
Points of emphasis:
  - \*If team has a Libero player, that team provides a Libero Tracker.
  - \*5<sup>th</sup> Set Coin Toss for Serve, Receive, Side. Do Not switch sides **During** 5<sup>th</sup> Set.
  - \*Center line violation for boys: some part of foot or hand **Must** be **on** Center line not over it.
  - \*Duties of R2: whistle 30 second warning between sets  
Whistle 15 second warning for Time Out  
If R2 makes a call, they must be on side of fault  
Double whistle for Substitution  
Must blow whistle to warn R1 if there is a need to address or resolve issue at scorer's table.

4. New Business: Modified Officials Mentoring - a Junior Official working with Senior Official at each match. Scheduling done by BOCES and may not always be matched accordingly.

**Section VIII**  
**Boys' Modified Volleyball Rules**  
**2014**

All applicable New York State Public High School Athletic regulations will apply to this sport.

**Match Conditions:**

1. Two nights of rest between contests. Contests may be played with only one night's rest three times per season for rescheduling purposes. A team may never play three days in a row.
2. The maximum number of contests in Section VIII is 11.
3. Eight practices are required before the first scrimmage.
4. Ten practices are required before the first interschool contest.
5. Two scrimmages are allowed.

**Match Rules:**

1. The minimum net height shall be 7' 4 1/8"
2. Antennas are required.
3. The front and sides of the official's stand must be padded up to 5'6".
4. Teams are to provide scorers and line judges.
5. A visible scoring device is required and must be visible to both teams.
6. The ball can be white or a combination of colors with at least one-third of the surface white. It must have a smooth leather or leather-like cover.
7. Volleyball line-up sheets must be carefully filled out and submitted 3 minutes prior to set one and 30 seconds prior to the start of sets 2, 3, 4 and 5 to the second referee.
8. Official warm up period is 6 minutes per team which includes serving. The visiting team has the first 6 minutes.
9. All matches shall consist of five sets.
10. Teams will stay on the same side for the first two sets, then switch. The same side will always serve first in the first four sets.
11. In the 5<sup>th</sup> set, teams will remain on the same side.
12. Rally scoring shall be utilized.
13. The number of points in each set shall be 20 points with a 25 point cap in all sets.
14. The winning team must win by 2 points until one team reaches 25 points.
15. The server must serve the ball with his feet behind the service line (end line). Stepping on or over the line is a foot fault resulting in loss of serve and a point for the opposing team. Officials CANNOT waive this rule. Section VIII will NOT move the service line up one meter.
16. Two tosses will be permitted per turn of service as long as the first attempt was a bad toss.
17. Server has 5 seconds to contact the ball for service.
18. Players cannot serve the ball off their hand.
19. The libero player is allowed and may serve in one position.
20. If using a libero player, a libero tracker needs to be provided by the school using the libero.
21. The pursuit rule is not used.
22. Eighteen substitutions are allowed.
23. Mixed uniforms are allowed but numbers must be on the front and back of the uniform.
24. No jewelry is permitted.
25. The wearing of religious articles requires a letter from the state.
26. Coaches can speak to the officials but may not argue judgment calls.
27. Officials will not tolerate unsportsmanship like behavior by players and coaches.

**TEAM ROSTERS**

**Teams should consist of:**

- A Roster and B Roster
- They should be of equal ability
- One roster plays 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> set, while the other roster plays 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> set.  
The 5<sup>th</sup> set is any combination

The maximum number of sets an athlete can play is 3 sets
